Embracing Environmental Responsibilities



Unveiling the Ocean's Secrets A Journey aboard India's RV Sindhu Sadhana

he vast expanse of the ocean holds a multitude of mysteries, its depths teeming with life and waiting resources to discovered. For India, unlocking these secrets is not just about scientific exploration, but about harnessing the ocean's potential economic growth and environmental sustainability. A key player in this endeavour is Research Vessel Sindhu Sadhana, India's first indigenously built, full ocean depth research vessel.

Acquired by CSIR-National Institute of Oceanography (CSIR-NIO) in December 2013, the RV Sindhu Sadhana is equipped with cutting-edge sensors equipment tailored for oceanographic research. Measuring 80 meters in length, 17.6 meters in breadth, and with a maximum draft of 5.8 meters, it ample boasts space accommodate 29 scientific staff and 28 crew members. With a cruising speed of 13.5 knots, the ship is capable of continuous operation at sea for up to 45 days without interruption.

RV Sindhu Sadhana, meaning "exploration of the ocean" in Sanskrit, is a testament to India's growing prowess in shipbuilding and scientific research. Launched in 2012 and formally dedicated to the nation in 2014, the vessel boasts impressive features. Its 80 meter length, 17.6 meter breadth, and 5.8 meter draft allow it to navigate even the deepest ocean trenches. The ship accommodate 29 scientific personnel and 28 crew members, providing a dedicated living and working space for extended research expeditions.

of RV Sindhu The heart Sadhana lies in its powerful diesel-electric propulsion system. Four 1150 kW caterpillar diesel generators provide the primary source of power, while a 350 kW harbour generator and a 160 kW emergency generator ensure uninterrupted operation. robust setup allows the ship to maintain a cruising speed of 13.5 knots and offers an impressive endurance of 45 days at sea, enabling researchers to venture far from the coast and conduct indepth studies.

A Hub of Scientific Inquiry

One of the most remarkable aspects of RV Sindhu Sadhana is its collection of specialised laboratories. Spread across 250 square meters, these labs are designed to cater to a wide range of scientific disciplines. Two wellequipped wet labs provide a dedicated space for the study of marine organisms and the analysis of water samples. A spacious dry lab serves as a versatile workspace for various research activities, while a computer and data processing lab ensures real- time analysis of information. analytical lab equipped with cutting- edge instruments further empowers researchers to delve deeper into their findings.

RV Sindhu Sadhana is not just a vessel; it's a mobile scientific platform brimming with sophisticated equipment. Single



and multi-beam echo sounders map the ocean floor in intricate detail, while sub-bottom profilers provide insights into the composition and structure beneath the seafloor. Gravity and magnetic field measurements offer valuable data on the Earth's

expert advice, and coordinate efforts with onshore support teams.

crust and mantle beneath the ocean, while acoustic Doppler current profilers track the movement of water masses. Conductivity- temperature- depth profilers (CTDs) create a comprehensive picture of the ocean's physical and chemical properties at various depths.

Unveiling the Ocean's Treasures

The ship's advanced winches and cranes are crucial for deploying and retrieving a wide range of sampling equipment. Aframe located at the stern side facilitates the launch and recovery of Remotely Operated Vehicles (ROVs), Autonomous Underwater Vehicles (AUVs), and other submersibles, allowing researchers to explore the ocean without human intervention. The A-frame located on the starboard side facilitates piston coring operation to collect 24 m long sediment cores. Specialised sampling tools like CTD rosettes, water samplers, grabs, and corers enable the collection of vital data on marine life, water quality, and seabed sediments.

Staying connected amidst the vastness of the ocean is essential RV Sindhu Sadhana's operations. The ship is equipped with a state- of- the- art communication system, featuring high- frequency. very-highfrequency, and ultra-highfrequency radio telephones. Highspeed data links enable continuous communication with shore stations, other ships, and even aircraft. This allows researchers to share real-time data with collaborators, seek

Can you elaborate on the specific features of RV Sindhu Sadhana that distinguish it as India's premier research vessel, particularly in terms of its capabilities for full ocean depth exploration and its contributions to advancing marine science?



Speciality of RV Sindhu Sadhana lies in its well-designed dry and wet laboratories to cater the needs of the oceanographers dealing with Geology-Geophysics, Physics, chemistry and Biology. This research vessel was designed with long experience of scientists of CSIR-NIO, Goa who have been working for more than five decades using other RVs and hence the Sindhu Sandhana incorporates the best facilities available in many other RVs. It starts with much stable and less noise making diesel-electric propulsion system, specialised winch facilities, gravity and piston coring facilities, multi-corer and seawater sampling facilities. Geophysical instruments, single and multi-beam eco sounders etc. Moreover, It has capabilities to study the entire ocean, right from coast to open ocean.

How has the acquisition of RV Sindhu Sadhana enhanced CSIR-NIO's capacity for conducting oceanographic research, and what significant scientific discoveries or insights have been made possible through its utilization?

Acquisition of RV Sindhu Sadhana in the CSIR-NIO research fleet has truly enhanced its research capabilities multi-fold. It allowed scientists to venture into the open ocean and performed cutting edge science in the open Indian Ocean. It has enhanced our capabilities to look for marine living and non-living resources in any part of the Ocean. Our capabilities to hunt for new resources and minerals such as critical metal important for storage of renewable energy in central Indian Ocean and along the hydrothermal ridges in the Indian Ocean have increased dramatically. It has helped discovering the methane cold seeps and presence of gas hydrates in our EEZ and locating the submarine volcanoes in the Andaman Sea. It is helping us in exploring the niche ecosystem in the Indian Ocean for drugs and nutraceutical from sea programme. It has augmented our capabilities to study the impact of climate change and anthropogenic activities in the Indian Ocean. RV Sindhu Sadhana played a central role in conducting the Genome Mapping of the Indian Ocean programme.

Could you share insights into the collaborative efforts between CSIR-NIO and other national or international institutions in leveraging RV Sindhu Sadhana for interdisciplinary research initiatives or addressing pressing environmental challenges in the maritime domain?

RV Sindhu Sadhana is playing a crucial role in many of the collaborative programmes of CSIR-NIO with Ministry of Earth Sciences, Department of Space etc. It participated in multi institutional programme of Monsoon Mission and will be helping the Department of Space in their Gaganyaan Mission.

The impact of RV Sindhu Sadhana extends far beyond the realm of oceanography. The vast data collected by the vessel serves as a valuable resource for a multitude of scientific disciplines. Marine biologists can gain deeper insights into the distribution, behaviour, and conservation needs of marine organisms. Geologists studying the Earth's crust benefit from data on plate tectonics and seabed mineral composition gathered during deep-water exploration missions. Meteorologists information on ocean currents and air- sea interactions to improve weather forecasting models.

India's vast coastline makes it particularly vulnerable to natural disasters like tsunamis and cyclones. RV Sindhu Sadhana plays a crucial role in disaster management and mitigation efforts. The ship's advanced sonar systems can be used to map the seabed and identify potential

hazards like underwater landslides that could trigger tsunamis. Data on ocean currents and wave patterns collected by RV Sindhu Sadhana helps in developing more accurate early warning systems for cyclones, enabling timely evacuation of coastal communities.

Complementing legislative endeavours, the Policy Statement for Abatement of Pollution and the National Conservation Strategy and Policy Statement on Environment and Development have provided strategic direction. The formulation of the Environmental Action Programme in 1993 further underscored the government's commitment to integrating environmental considerations into development agendas.

The Constitution of India provisions for environmental protection under Article 48A and Article 51A(g). Article 48A states that the state shall endeavour to protect and improve the environment and safeguard the forests and wildlife of the country. Article 51A(g) makes it a fundamental duty of every citizen of India to protect and improve the natural environment including forests, lakes, rivers, and wildlife. India has enacted several environmental laws, such as the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Wildlife Protection Act, 1972, and the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. These laws are enforced by various regulatory bodies such as the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), the State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs), and the National Green Tribunal (NGT).

Watershed Moments that Shaped India's Environmental Legal Framework

Vellore Citizens Welfare Forum v. Union of India (1996): In this landmark case, the Supreme Court of India emphasised the "polluter pays" principle. It held that industries causing environmental pollution must bear the cost of remediation and compensate affected communities. This decision strengthened environmental enforcement and accountability.

Taj Trapezium Case (2000): Concerned about the deteriorating condition of the Taj Mahal due to air pollution, the Supreme Court established the Taj Trapezium Zone (TTZ) around the monument. The court imposed strict regulations on industries, vehicular emissions, and construction activities within the TTZ to protect this iconic heritage site.

MC Mehta v. Union of India (1986): MC Mehta, an environmental activist, filed a petition against the pollution caused by hazardous industries in Delhi. The Supreme Court ordered the closure of polluting industries and mandated the use of cleaner technologies. This case set a precedent for environmental litigation in India.

Oleum Gas Leak Case (1987): The Bhopal gas tragedy, one of the world's worst industrial disasters, led to the leakage of methyl isocyanate gas from a Union Carbide pesticide plant. The legal battle sought compensation for victims and highlighted the need for stringent safety regulations and corporate accountability.

Forest Rights Act (2006): The Forest Rights Act recognised the rights of forest- dwelling communities, including tribal and indigenous groups, over forestland. It aimed to correct historical injustices and promote sustainable forest management. The act empowered local communities to protect their environment and traditional livelihoods.

Vedanta Mining Case (2013): The Supreme Court cancelled Vedanta Resources' bauxite mining project in Niyamgiri Hills, Odisha. The court upheld the rights of indigenous Dongria- Kondh tribes and their cultural and environmental concerns. This decision reinforced the importance of community con-sent in natural resource extraction.

Ganga Pollution Cases: Over the years, various legal battles have been fought to clean the Ganges River. The courts have issued directives to control industrial effluents, sewage discharge, and unauthorised constructions along the riverbanks. These cases highlight the ongoing struggle to restore the sacred Ganga to its pristine state.

Goa Mining Ban (2018): The Supreme Court suspended iron ore mining in Goa due to environmental violations. The ban aimed to protect fragile ecosystems, prevent illegal mining, and ensure sustainable resource use. It underscored the need for responsible mining practices.

Eligibility for PG Courses: At the postgraduate level, candidates aiming for degree and diploma courses in Environmental Law should possess an undergraduate law degree from a recognised university with a minimum aggregate score ranging from 45% to 55%.







Forest Conservation and Biodiversity

We understand that deforestation and illegal logging can threaten wildlife habitat. Examples like the destruction of mangrove forests in the Sundarbans and deforestation in the Western Ghats make it clear that more efforts are needed towards forest conservation. Wildlife species, such as tigers, elephants, and rhinos, are endangered.

Forest Area:

- India's forest cover was 23.7% in 2023 which is projected to increase by 24% in 2024.
- India increased forest cover by more than 2.2 lakh hectares in 2022, the highest rate in the world
- In 2014, India's forest area was only 21.7%
- "Mission Green India" initiative aims to plant 100 crore trees by 2030

Biodiversity:

- India is home to 11% of the world's known species, including 8% of mammals, 13% of birds, 7% of reptiles, 6% of amphibians and 10% of fishes.
- India has set a target to conserve 12% of known species by 2024, up from 1% in 2018.
- India launched the National Biodiversity Strategy and Action Plan 2016-2030 in 2018, which aims to halt biodiversity loss by 2030.
- India has established many protected areas and national parks to preserve the diversity of flora and

Climate Change

India is also not untouched by the effects of climate change. Incidents like abnormal weather changes, flash floods, and heatwaves are on the rise. In 2023, floods wreaked havoc in the Kedarnath region of Uttarakhand, killing thousands of people and destroying property worth crores. Apart from this, cyclones in the Bay of Bengal and the Arabian Sea have also caused huge devastation in the coastal areas

Renewable Energy

India is facing many problems in the field of renewable energy. One of the biggest problems they face is high costs, which may discourage investors. There is also the challenge of storage shortage and grid integration. Land use needs and policy uncertainty are also important problems. Also, lack of infrastructure, lack of awareness and lack of talent are some major problems associated with renewable energy.

- India aims to install 500 GW of renewable energy capacity by 2030.
- India had set a target of installing 30 GW of renewable energy capacity in 2023.
- India installed 175 GW renewable energy capacity in 2022, ranking fourth in the world.
- India installed 10.5 GW of solar power capacity in 2021, the second highest in the world.
- India has also started investing in Green Hydrogen production, which is considered the future of clean energy.

Waste Management

Every year, millions of tonnes of waste is generated. much of which is not properly managed. Plastic waste in particular has caused huge harm to the environment. India has taken several important steps to tackle plastic pollution. Many states have banned single-use plastics and promoted alternatives. Under this, special attention has been given to recycling and reusing plastic waste.

- The average level of PM2.5 in India is projected to reduce to 55 µg/m3 in 2024.
- The average level of PM2.5 in India in 2023 was 59 μg/m3, down from 64 μg/m3 in 2014.
- India launched the National Clean Air Programme (NAP) 2.0 in 2022, which aims to reduce PM2.5 and PM10 levels by 40% in 100 cities by 2024.
- India launched the National Ganga River Mission in 2021 with a target to clean 80% of the river basin by
- India has initiated several policies to promote the adoption of electric vehicles, which will help in reducing air pollution.
- India has also increased investment in Sewage Treatment Plants (STP) to reduce water pollution.

Theme of World Environment Day 2024 is 'Land Restoration, Desertification and Drought Resilience Land Restoration' - According to the United Nations Convention, 40 percent of the Earth's land has been destroyed, affecting half the world's population. Nearly half of global GDP is at risk.

Desertification - The incidence and duration of drought has increased by 29 percent since 2000 - without immediate action, drought could affect more than threequarters of the world's population by 2050.

Drought Resilience - Land restoration is a key pillar of the UN Ecosystem Restoration Decade (2021-2030), a rallying call to protect and restore ecosystems around the world, which is essential to achieving the Sustainable Development Goals.

Worldwide Crisis

Amazon Rainforest, Brazil

The Amazon rainforest of Brazil is known as the 'Lungs' of the Earth'. In 2023, deforestation in the Amazon broke the record of the previous ten years. The main reason for deforestation is to prepare land for agriculture and timber trade. This is not only destroying the habitat of local wildlife, but also causing huge emissions of carbon dioxide, which is further fueling climate change.

Australia Wildfires

The massive wildfires that broke out in Australia in 2020 attracted the world's attention. The fire incinerated millions of acres of land, destroyed thousands of homes and killed millions of wildlife. The intensity of the fire is due to climate change, with increased temperatures and drought conditions further exacerbating the crisis. It seriously affected Australia's ecosystems and raised serious questions about wildlife conservation.

California, United States

In 2023, the fire in California broke all previous records. The main cause of the fire is climate change, which promotes drought and heat waves. Additionally, water crisis is also a serious issue in California, where water scarcity is hampering agricultural and civil water supplies

Melting of Glaciers

The melting of glaciers in the Arctic region is a clear sign of global climate change. According to scientists, Arctic ice is melting rapidly due to which the sea level is rising. ■ Indian Embassy Rescues 60 Nationals from Cambodia Job Scam



In a proactive move to safeguard its citizens from fraudulent employment schemes in Cambodia, the Indian Embassy facilitated the safe return of 60 Indian nationals on May 23. The rescue operation, executed in collaboration with Cambodian authorities, liberated the individuals from precarious conditions in Jinbei-4 on May 20. Efforts to address the plight of Indian nationals trapped in Cambodia are ongoing, with diplomatic channels actively engaged. A dedicated team of Embassy officials stationed in Sihanoukville is extending necessary aid to those in distress, urging others facing similar challenges to seek assistance promptly. Over 360 individuals have been repatriated thus far.

■ Andhra Born Gopi Thotakura Makes History as First Indian Space Tourist

Indian expatriate Gopi Thotakura etched his name in the annals of space exploration, becoming the first Indian space tourist. He joined the crew for Jeff Bezos' Blue Origin's NS-25 mission, marking a significant milestone for India's space aspirations. Shri Thotakura, hailing from Andhra Pradesh, embarked on the journey alongside five other crew members, including former Air Force Captain Ed Dwight. The mission, Blue Origin's seventh human spaceflight, aimed to advance the frontiers of space tourism while promoting the protection of Earth.

■ India Climbs 15 Position in WEF's Travel and Tourism Development Index

India has climbed to the 39th position in the World Economic Forum's Travel & Tourism Development Index 2024, while US topped the list. India also ranks the highest in South Asia among the lower-middle-income economies. Earlier, India was ranked 54th in 2021 index. India's significant leap in the rankings underscores its growing competitiveness in the global tourism landscape. The biennial index analysed the travel and tourism sectors of 119 countries, evaluating them on a range of factors and policies that foster tourism development.




 NCB Inaugurates Incubation Centre for Fostering Innovation in Building Materials

■ India Mourns Iran President's Death in Helicopter Crash



India observed state mourning on May 21 following the tragic demise of Iran's President Dr. Seyed Ebrahim Raisi and Foreign Minister Hossein Amir-Abdollahian in a helicopter crash. Flags across the nation were flown at half-mast in honor of the two leaders. Iranian President Dr. Seyed Ebrahim Raisi and his foreign minister met a tragic end on May 19 when their helicopter crashed in mountainous terrain shrouded in heavy fog. The incident occurred during their return from a visit to the

border with Azerbaijan in Iran's northwest, claiming the lives of both leaders.

UN Report: Half of World's Pastures Degraded by Overuse, Climate Change

A United Nations report released by the United Nations Convention to Combat Desertification (UNCCD) highlights alarming degradation of natural pasture lands worldwide due to overexploitation and climate change impacts. The report warns that half of the world's natural pasture lands, including savannas, wetlands, deserts, and grasslands, have suffered degradation, jeopardising food supplies and livelihoods globally. The deterioration of rangelands, which comprise a sixth of the world's food supplies, poses a significant risk to food security. Factors such as population growth, urbanisation, and escalating food demand have led to overgrazing and conversion of natural pastures into intensive croplands, resulting in soil fertility decline and exacerbated drought conditions, according to the UNCCD. The report, based on surveys from experts in over 40 countries, revises previous estimates, indicating a more extensive and urgent issue than previously recognised.

Indian Bureaucrat becomes UN Chief's Disaster Risk Reduction Representative

Indian bureaucrat Shri Kamal Kishore has commenced his tenure as the Special Representative of the UN Secretary-General for Disaster Risk Reduction and the head of the United Nations Office for Disaster Risk Reduction (UNDRR). On May 20, the UNDRR welcomed Shri Kishore as he stepped into his new role, succeeding Mr. Mami Mizutori of Japan. Expressing his commitment, Shri Kishore emphasised the crucial role of UNDRR in global efforts to mitigate disaster risks amidst escalating vulnerabilities. With nearly three decades of experience



in disaster risk reduction across various levels, including government, the United Nations, and civil society, Shri Kishore brings a wealth of expertise to his new position. He has notably served as the Head of India's National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) since 2015 and led the Group of 20 (G20) Working Group on Disaster Risk Reduction during India's G20 presidency.

■ Vietnam's Appoints Top Police Officer as New President



Vietnam's parliament has elected Mr. To Lam as the country's new President. In accordance with the nation's one-party state protocols, lawmakers unanimously voted on a resolution endorsing Mr. Lam's election after a secret ballot, with Mr. Lam being the sole candidate for the position. As the head of the public security ministry, he has played a pivotal role in an anti-corruption campaign known as the "blazing furnace," aimed at combating widespread corruption. Following his election, Mr. Lam affirmed his commitment to continue the fight against corruption, emphasising his

determination to tackle the issue.

■ UN Raises India's 2024 Growth Forecast Citing Investment, Consumption Surge

India's economic outlook for 2024 received a boost as the United Nations revised its growth projections upward, citing robust public investment and resilient private consumption. The UN's mid-year update, titled World Economic Situation and Prospects, predicts India's economy to expand by 6.9 percent, surpassing earlier estimates of 6.2 percent. This aligns with the recent upward revision by the International Monetary Fund (IMF), signaling growing optimism about India's economic trajectory. Despite challenges posed by subdued external demand impacting merchandise exports, India's pharmaceuticals and chemicals sectors are anticipated to drive significant export growth, according to the UN report.

 Deepthi Jeevanji Clinches Gold, Sets World Record at Para Athletics Championships

Indian para athlete. Deepthi Jeevanji made history on May smashing the world record with a remarkable time of 55.06 seconds in the women's 400m T20 category at the ongoing Para Athletics World Championship 2024 in Kobe, Japan. Jeevanji's outstanding performance not only secured her a gold medal but also set a new benchmark in para



athletics. Earlier in the qualifying rounds, she showcased her prowess by setting an Asian record with a time of 56.18 seconds, earning her a spot in the finals. This victory adds to Jeevanji's growing list of achievements, following her gold medal triumph in the women's 400m T20 event at the Asian Para Games 2023.

■ BCCI Lays Foundation Stone for Training Facilities in Northeast India
The Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) has laid the foundation stone for
state-of-the-art training facilities in the northeastern region of India. The initiative
aims to bolster cricket infrastructure and nurture talent in the region. The indoor
cricket academies, set to be established in Shillong, Itanagar, Kohima, Aizawl,
Imphal, and Gangtok, will be equipped with world-class amenities including indoor
nets, swimming pools, and fitness centers, will provide year-round training
opportunities for budding cricketers.

WFI President Confirms: No Trials for Paris Olympics Wrestlers Wrestling Federation of India (WFI) President Shri Sanjay Singh has officially announced that trials will not be conducted to select wrestlers for the Paris Olympics 2024. Instead, athletes who have secured Olympic quotas will directly represent

2024. Instead, athletes who have secured Olympic quotas will directly represent India at the prestigious event. The decision puts an end to speculation surrounding the selection process for the Paris Olympics. Earlier, there were rumors suggesting the possibility of trials being held. However, the WFI's announcement clarifies the path for Indian wrestlers heading to Paris. India concluded its campaign at the World Olympic Wrestling Qualifiers with Aman Sehrawat and Nisha Dahiya securing the quotas in men's and women's wrestling categories respectively.
