### B. Selection Methodology

- The selection is based on the percentage of marks obtained in the prescribed qualification mentioned above and performance in Interview for Dredge Cadets

For candidates belonging to OBC category, the Community Certificate should not be more than one year old and should, among others, specifically mention that person does not belong to a creamy layer.
